***Preschool & Children Teacher Training.....Facilitator: Deborah Strubinger**

***Back to the Basics and Beyond*..... Room 204**

Missionary Sunday School, “takes a closer look at just one of the elements: Missionary Mentality. Author David Francis strives to answer the question ‘What might a Sunday School class or small group look like if it saw itself as a missionary enterprise—thinking and acting out of a missionary mindset?’” In this breakout session, we will take a closer look how this concept even applies to our preschool and children’s Sunday School classes.

***Missionary Sunday School* Room 203**

This breakout is based on David Francis’ book and will discuss “the key elements of transformational churches: Missionary Mentality. The very idea of Sunday School class or small group acting from a missionary mindset may be jolting to some. Over the year, ‘Sunday School’ has become almost synonymous with ‘Bible Study.’ Likewise, the most common word to describe ‘Small Group’ has probably been ‘Community.’ Of course, most Sunday School classes enjoy community, and most small groups enjoy Bible study. It is the rare class or small group, however, which discovers the joy of becoming a missionary enterprise. Find out how to put a missionary mentality into your group.”

***Identifying the Actual Church You Attend* Room 202**

In this study, we will discuss the seven types of churches, plus the church you may want to attend as opposed to the church you may actually be attending, and the major reasons why pastors and congregations find themselves “disappointed” and “disillusioned” — often resulting in internal struggles, church splits and forced terminations. The truth is, far too many churches lack a real understanding of their true identity.

We will discuss the ways that worship can help transform lives and churches. Based on chapter 7 of *Transformational Church* by Rainer and Stetzer, we will examine worshipping in unity, using worship to evangelize and musical techniques to capture the attention of the congregation.
